Job Summary:

Ridley Performing Arts Program (RPAP) is seeking passionate and dynamic Workshop Instructors to lead engaging classes for performers of varying ages and skill levels. Instructors may specialize in singing, dancing, acting, or a specific theatre skill (such as improvisation, stage combat, audition prep, etc.). This role is ideal for theater professionals and teaching artists who thrive on inspiring others, fostering creativity, and sharing their expertise.

Key Responsibilities:

- Develop and lead a workshop lesson plan tailored to your area of expertise (singing, dancing, acting, or a special theatre skill).
- Create a positive and supportive environment that encourages participation, risk-taking, and growth.

Compensation:

 - 8-10 Week Class 2-3 hours, with atleast 15 kids: \$1,000
