Job Summary:

Ridley Performing Arts Program (RPAP) is seeking a Director for its concert version of Little Shop of Horrors, scheduled for May 2026. The Director will oversee the artistic vision and staging of the production, collaborating with the Music Director and creative team to create an engaging, streamlined concert presentation of this beloved musical.

Key Responsibilities:

- Attend and lead rehearsals on Mondays, Thursdays, and Saturdays throughout April 2026.
- Develop and communicate a clear artistic vision tailored to a concert-style performance.
- Stage the concert presentation, including actor movement, script-in-hand performance flow, and integration of minimal scenic/prop elements as needed.
- Collaborate with the Music Director to ensure smooth transitions between dialogue and music.
- Guide and support performers in character development and storytelling within the concert format.
- Foster a positive, encouraging, and professional rehearsal environment.

Required Qualifications:

- Demonstrated experience as a stage director in musical theatre.
- Strong leadership and organizational skills with the ability to run efficient rehearsals.
- Excellent communication skills and the ability to collaborate with a creative team.
- Experience directing concert, staged reading, or semi-staged productions.
- Professionalism, punctuality, and a collaborative spirit.
